FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Motorsport UK Permit number - TBC
2. Please report for signing-on at the Manor House Inn, Carterway Heads (A68), DL8 9LX .Map Ref: 042522
W3W: lucky.dozens.squaring
from 18:30 and closes at 19:30.
3. Please have your club card, any outstanding fees and insurance cover premium ready. Please reward their hospitality by purchasing a drink before the start and at the end.
4. MTC0 is inside the Inn, this is where you collect your Route Instructions.
5. MTC 1 Will be outside the Inn in the car park. Start time for Car 1 is 8:01.
Route Instructions will be issued to Beginners and Novices 30 minutes before their due start time, Experts 15 minutes.

6. The total route is approximately 59 miles. There is no petrol at the start or finish. The nearest filling station is in Consett. A reminder that you need both Map 87 and 88 for this event.
7. There will be numerous route checks, which may be information from signposts or code boards. Competitors are responsible for entering the required information in the appropriate box on their timecard.
8. There may be some secret checks. These will be manned and have a 'SC' Board.
9. Please drive with care and show consideration for other road users.
10. There will be Quiet Zones, which will be identified en-route. Please reduce speed, travel in as high a gear as possible using dipped headlights. Quiet Zones may be observed. Any competitor failing to drive in the appropriate manner WILL BE EXCLUDED.
11. Your time cards will detail where you can make up lateness. Please try and do this where possible.
12. Please note the use of mobile phones for anything other than emergency phone calls is not permitted. You will need either a watch or a clock to follow your time schedule. Any competitor found to be in breach of this WILL BE EXCLUDED.
13. It would be useful to carry your own clock to follow your schedule time however, all official rally timepieces will be deemed to be correct.
14. There is one "no entry" sign used on the event as a wrong slot ends in a farm yard. If you see it please observe it!
