Final Instructions

1. The event will start and finish at Hexham Auction Mart. This can be found on map 87 at grid reference 939 647. The post code is NE46 3SG and the What3words location is goofy.galaxies.icon
Trailer parking, noise test, scrutineering and signing on are all located here, please see the enclosed plan for details.

The café will be open and serving meals before the event, please do reward them with your custom.

2. The schedule will be as follows:

16:30 Noise and Scrutineering open
19:15 Competitors briefing – Inside auction mart
20:00 Car 0 departs MTC 1 – Inside auction mart
 (Cars will start at 1 minute intervals)
03:15 Car 0 due at MTC 22 – Inside auction mart

(note: other than passing scrutineering, signing on, giving generously to our chosen charity and stuffing your faces with food from the café, there won't be anything to plot before your start time of 20:00 plus your start number)

4. Scrutineering notes

MOT certificates and DVLA V5 documents will be checked (where applicable)

Red warning triangles are required to be carried throughout this event and used appropriately, along with OK/SOS boards.

A small spill kit must be carried by each car.

Although the event is using a Navigational Permit, the cars will need to comply with Road Rally Noise Regulations

5. **Licences and club cards will be inspected at signing on.**

6. Control Procedure

All time controls will be denoted by a 'C' board

All competitors **MUST** stop at the board before calmly moving forward to the marshal

The time given will be when you stop at the board

Secret checks will also be found on the route, denoted by a 'SC' board

All competitors **MUST** stop at the board before calmly moving forward to the marshal

Stopping at the board, in advance of the marshal is to protect our marshals

Failure to stop at the board, will result in a penalty

Examples of the boards will be shown at the drivers briefing

7. Route Checks

The route checks used on this event will be car number plates split in half, most will be at SGW junctions, some will just be found on the correct route, but the navigation will tell you when to expect one.

As is traditional on Hexham events, we will also use signposts as route checks where possible. These will all be at SGW junctions and will be facing you (assuming you arrive from the correct direction?). At the road sign you will be asked to record the correct place name from the distance given, or the correct distance for the Place name given. The time card will tell you what you are looking for.

8. Navigation

13. Results and Awards

This year our results will be calculated and hosted by Rally Roots. The only way to view the results will be online using the website www.rallyroots.com If you have a results query, please fill in a results query form and hand it to the Competitor Liaison Officer, Lynsey Procter. You will find these forms in your competitor packs, and they will also be available from the final control inside the finish venue.

We will get the results finalised as quickly as possible after the rally and present the awards straight away, please stay to collect any awards you win as we don't intend to send them out. If you haven't won an award please stay to support and applaud those who have.

14. Navigators Equipment

We advise that all navigators bring an A4 sized clip board with them to hold the time card, this makes it easier for you and our marshals to fill it in correctly. Also, bringing some Sellotape with you may help as we are supplying an extract of an adjacent map that you will be using to navigate on.

15. Beginners

You will be provided with a marked map book that details the whole route, you will receive this as you check out of MTC1. So that you know what to expect, we will provide an example of the presentation in your competitor pack at signing on, you can then familiarise yourselves with it and ask any questions before the event starts.

16. Charity Collection
