Driving Standards will be more rigorously observed in 2024 and anyone found guilty of reckless driving will be excluded and will not get an entry in subsequent events.

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

- 1. Hexham & District Motor Club will promote the March Melee 12 Car Rally on the 6th of March 2024. The event will be governed by the General Regulations of the MSUK Ltd. And the following Supplementary Regulations.
- 2. MSA Permit Number: 135086
- 3. The Start will be from Glendinning of Prudhoe (88/089535) and finish at the Dr Syntax, New Ridley. The event will have a mileage of at least 59 miles. O.S. **Sheets 87 and 88** will be required.
- 4. The event is open to members of the promoting club with an RS Clubman licence. Club cards and licences must be shown at signing on.
- 5. The program will be :- First car will start at **20:01**. Cars will start at 1 minute intervals, sign on no later than 30 minutes before due start time.

Cars must be taxed and insured for road section car rally use on the public highway. Road section Insurance will be available purchase before or on the day of the event

6. The event will consist of three classes :-

Expert – Where the navigator has previously won a Hexham 12 Car overall

Novice – Everyone else

Beginner – Where the navigator gets a marked map. (Only eligible for half points in the 12 car championship)

7. AWARDS: 1st. Category Crew (Expert)........ An Award (If sufficient entries)

1st. Category Crew (Novice) An Award (If sufficient Entries)

1st. Category Crew (Beginners) An Award (If sufficient Entries)

8. The entry list opens with the publication of these regulations and closes on 28/02/24. The entry fee is £25:00 The maximum entry is 12 cars, entries will be accepted in order of receipt.

N.B NO MORE THAN 12 CARS WILL BE ACCEPTED ENTER EARLY TO AVOID DISAPPOINTMENT

- 10. Provisional results will be announced at the finish Any protests must be made in accordance with GR. 05.1.
- 11. Crews will be supplied with a numbered Time Card/ Route Check card at Signing On. Route Instructions will be issued as follows:-

Novices/ Beginners: 30 minutes before due start time

Experts: 10 minutes before due start time

All crews are issued the same route instructions with the exception of beginners who will receive a marked map.

These will take the form of map references, tulips and symbols from OS map, grid lines, herring bone and will provide all the information required to comply with GR. K5.2. Final Regulations will be e-mailed to competitors prior to the event.

12. Amendments to General Regulations:

Ties will be decided a) Lowest penalty on regularity. B) Oldest car

Passage Controls / Route Checks will be Code Boards or Signposts or other signs or manned.

Missed Time Control = 30 Minutes Penalty

Missed Passage Controls will incur a 5 minute penalty.

Stopping in sight of a regularity Inter or Finish = 30 Minute Penalty

Observed by an organizer to be Recce-ing = EXCLUSION

Excessive Noise or Speed in a Quiet Zone = EXCLUSION

- 13. Cars must comply with Motorsport UK regulation [R] 16.3
- 14. Any driver found guilty of careless or reckless driving, excessive noise, not dipping lights in a Quiet Zone will be excluded from the event.
