### SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. Hexham & District Motor Club will promote the **November Handicap 12 Car Rally on** November 15th. 2023. The event will be governed by the General Regulations of the MSUK Ltd. And the following Supplementary Regulations.

2. MSA Permit Number : 133115

3. The Start will be from Henshaw Garage, Bardon Mill and the Finish will be at the Wallace Arms, Featherstone.. The event will have a mileage of at least 55 miles. O.S. **Sheets 86 Edition D1** will be required.

4. The event is open to members of the promoting club.

**Club cards must be shown at signing on.**

5. The programme will be :- First car will start at **20:01**. Cars will start at 1 minute intervals, sign on 30 minutes before start. Signing On will be via Entry Form

Cars must be taxed and insured for use on the public highway.

6. The event will consist of Three classes :- Novice/ Expert/ Masters

7. AWARDS : 1<sup>st</sup>. Category Crew (Expert)..... An Award ( If sufficient entries )  
1<sup>st</sup>. Category Crew (Novice) ..... An Award ( If sufficient Entries )  
1<sup>st</sup>.Category Crew ( Masters ) An Award ( If sufficient Entries )

8. The entry list opens with the publication of these regulations and closes on 18 / 10/ 23 and close on 08/ 11/ 23. The entry fee is £25:00 The maximum entry is 12 cars, entries will be accepted in order of receipt. .

10. Provisional results will be announced at the finish Any protests must be made in accordance with GR. O5.1.

11. Crews will be supplied with a numbered Time Card, Route Check card and Route Instructions . These will take the form Map References, tulips and symbols from OS map or a simple tulip road book and, if requested, a marked map for Novice and Beginners, and will provide all the information required to comply with GR. K5.2. Final Regulations will be e-mailed to competitors prior to the event.

12. Amendments to General Regulations :

Ties will be decided a) Lowest penalty on regularity. B) Oldest car

Passage Controls / Route Checks will be Code Boards or Signposts or other signs or manned.

Missed Time Control = 30 Minutes Penalty

Missed Passage Controls will incur a 5 minute penalty.

Stopping in sight of a regularity Inter or Finish = 30 Minute Penalty

**Observed by an organizer to be Recce-ing = EXCLUSION**

**Excessive Noise or Speed in a Quiet Zone = EXCLUSION**

13. Standard type cars only will be eligible to compete

14. **Any driver found guilty of careless or reckless driving, excessive noise, not dipping lights in a Quiet Zone will be excluded from the event.**

**INSURANCE :- All cars are required to be covered by insurance while competing on this event, if you have not made your own arrangements, cover is available via the REIS Rally Guard cover, please signify this on the entry form and pay the appropriate fee.**
