FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Signing-On**. Competitors are to report for signing-on between 18.30 - 19.15 hrs in the bar at the Travellers' Rest, Slaley, NE46 1TT. (GR 87 95905855).
2. **Competitors Briefing**. There will be a combined briefing for Competitors & Marshals at 19.15 hrs.
3. **Documentation**. Please have the following documentation ready at signing-On.
 - a. Club Card
 - b. Outstanding Fees
 - c. **Evidence of Insurance**
 - d. Competitors using the Event Insurance must pay the premium at Signing-On.
4. **Route Instructions** Route Instructions are to be collected from Main Time Control (MTC 0) which will be at the same location as the Signing-On.
 - a. Beginners and Novices will receive their Route Instructions 30 minutes before their due start time at MTC 1.

Note: Beginners will receive a marked map. This information is not to be shared.

 - b. Experts will receive their Route Instructions 15 minutes before their due start time at MTC 1.
5. **Main Time Control 0** Route Instructions are issued from MTC 0 which is inside the pub.

6. Main Time Control 1 MTC 1 will be in the car park outside the pub.
7. Route The route is approximately 60 miles and Experts & Novice crews will need Map 87 Hexham & Haltwhistle (latest Edition 2024).
8. Fuel. There are no fuel stations on the route.
9. Route Checks (RC) If they follow the correct route, Competitors will pass RC which may have the information required from signposts, Code Boards (CB) and possibly Marshals. The Competitor is responsible for entering the required information in the appropriate box on their Route Card.
10. Secret Checks (SC) There will be a number of Secret Checks where the Marshal will sign the Route Card in the appropriate box.
11. Driving Standards Please drive with care and consideration for other road users, we want to come back in the future and upsetting the locals will kill off our sport.
12. Quiet Zones & Black Spots. Speed limits in villages must be obeyed and competitors must reduce their speed, travel in as high a gear as possible and use dipped headlights. There are some isolated hamlets and farms where 'Quiet Boards' will be set up by the organisers. Please obey these as we do not wish to upset anyone. Quiet Zones and Black Spots may be observed and any Competitor failing to drive in the appropriate manner WILL BE EXCLUDED.
13. Black Spots There may be Black Spots detailed in the Route Instructions (RU). DO NOT ENTER THE LOCATION GIVEN.
14. Time Cards & Lateness(TC). Competitors Time Cards will detail where they can make up lateness. Try and do this where possible.
15. Mobile Phones Mobile Phones can be used only for emergencies or to contact the organiser for assistance. Competitors need a watch or clock to follow their time schedule. Any competitor found in breach of this WILL BE EXCLUDED.
16. Rally Time The clocks used by the marshals are deemed to have the correct, 'Rally Time'.
17. EMERGENCY NUMBER. In the event of an emergency please call or text Tommy & Bob Henderson on 07762707446. Tommy & Bob Henderson will be running the Opening Car so might not return your call immediately.
